

The “**Customs and Freight Forwarding**” program at “**Pjetër Budi**” College offers a very favorable perspective for students by preparing them for a labor market that is continuously growing in Kosovo as well as in the region and beyond. The growth of the international trade sector, trade liberalization, the development of logistics, and the expansion of transport companies have created a sustained demand for qualified professionals in customs, freight forwarding, and logistics management.

Students who complete this program gain theoretical and practical knowledge of customs procedures, documentation in international transport, multimodal transport, supply chain management, and relevant legislation, making them competitive and highly sought after in the labor market.

From a professional perspective, graduates have broad employment opportunities in customs agencies, freight forwarding companies, customs terminals, operators or logistics companies, transport companies, manufacturing and importing companies, state institutions, transport insurance companies, as well as in international organizations dealing with trade and logistics. Practical skills developed in the program include subjects such as: International Freight Forwarding, International Transport, Customs Systems, Customs Knowledge of Goods, Customs Law, Logistics and Supply Chain Management, Applied Systems in Customs and Freight Forwarding, and semester-based practical courses: Practical Work in Customs and Practical Work in Freight Forwarding.

These also include the use of electronic customs systems, goods valuation, tariff classification, logistics planning, and management of transport documentation, thereby directly increasing students’ employability and their ability to adapt to the modern requirements of the respective sector.

The long-term perspective for students is also very promising, as the sectors of customs, freight forwarding, foreign trade, logistics, and international transport are undergoing technological transformation, requiring professionals who master knowledge in process digitalization, supply chain security, international transport standards, and integration into global markets.

The program is specifically designed to build these core competencies, skills, and knowledge, enabling students to become active participants in current and future developments in the fields of customs, logistics, foreign trade, and international transport.
